COURSE FORMAT

This course is a level 5, 130 hour, 4 week TEFL certification. It's intensive and includes many teaching practises and planning sessions. You'll be studying from 8.30am to 4.00pm Monday to Friday.



TEACHING PRACTICES

You'll have at least 10 hours of teaching practicals throughout the course. Each day you'll also be lesson planning and studying new teaching methods.



TYPE OF ASSESSMENT

You'll be assessed continually throughout the 4 weeks training with observances from your trainers and peers.



COURSE LOCATION AND CENTRE

The training centre is located in central Chiang Mai, a short trip from the old town, and has so many things to do and see locally! You're surrounded by temples, markets, shopping, food and more.



REQUIREMENTS

The age requirement is generally 18 to 55 years old, however we welcome all applications on a case by case basis. Most candidates are 21+ years old, a Bachelor's degree is essential.



JOB MARKET AND EMPLOYMENT POSSIBILITY

There are hundreds of TEFL jobs throughout the country. You'll have full assistance in securing your TEFL role after training. The team will ensure your needs are met. Most jobs are in schools, ranging from kindergarten to high school. Occasionally there are summer camps and language centre positions, as well as online teaching opportunities.



VISA REQUIREMENTS

Visa information changes all the time. Most candidates enter on a pre-purchased tourist visa. Following the course and once you've secured your new job, you'll be guided through the process of applying for a non immigrant B visa and work permit. WORK IN THAILAND

Most teaching jobs in Thailand are in government schools, with ages ranging from kindergarten, through to high school.

You can expect to work on the mainland, Monday to Friday, from around 8am to 4pm. You'll be teaching around 20 hours per week, and lesson planning and marking in your free periods.

Peak hiring months are May and November, as there are only 2 long terms in Thailand each year. There are jobs all year round in English camps, summer camps, language centres, and online teaching. A usual contract length begins around 5 months.

You can expect to earn 35,000-45,000 Thai Baht (approx \$1000-\$1200 USD), per month as a minimum. Some schools do pay more, depending on experience.

Thailand is the hub of southeast Asia and in the last 20 years, it has developed into the popular destination we all know and love today!

Chiang Mai has a population of approx 8 million, the size of London, UK. Outside the city, you'll find small towns and villages. All with the essentials; a school, shop, bank, doctor and so on.

With your generous salary teaching English, you'll have the means to explore and travel the stunning islands of Thailand. Koh means island in Thai. The most famous and packed with things to do include Samui, Pha Ngan, Phi Phi, Tao, Samet, Khood, Lipe, Lanta. You'll find beaches that are out of this world and will be able to explore the lush forests and stunning waterfalls.

Thailand is predominantly a Buddhist country, Monks hold extremely high rank, only the Monarchy being higher. The temples are out of this world and you're likely to see a statue of Buddha around every corner.

You'll be amazed by the plentiful, fresh and cheap street food! A meal costs around \$1 USD from a street vendor and there's something to suit everyone's taste! Thai people don't generally cook, or have kitchens in their homes and with fresh, cheap food so readily available, it's not hard to understand why!

Be sure to brush up on Thai etiquette before you arrive!

Thai people are extremely laid back – horizontal in fact. This may be a world away from what you're used to, but we can assure you that you'll enjoy it after a while. You won't find a friendlier nation. It's called the land of smiles for a reason!
